ICS SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

The Summer Internship Programme is designed to provide a hands-on, real-world learning experience for our students from Grades 10-12 (age 16 and up) in the fields they want to pursue. An internship can be salaried or unpaid or offered a stipend (to be decided by the company) and the duration could be anywhere from one week to two months.

Internships are an important part of a student's academic journey. An internship can provide a student with clarity regarding what a certain job entails, confirmation that this career choice is the path they want to pursue and help with choosing IB subjects and university selection offers. Internships also reflect well on a student in their university applications and sometimes a successful internship can lead to a permanent job after university.

STUDENTS - HOW DO I APPLY?

Applicants for an internship opportunity are requested to submit the following documents electronically to the University and Career Counsellor at rdoell@icsz.ch by Monday 11 March.

- Letter of intent for a specific internship
- Curriculum Vitae

Selection interviews with the IB Coordinator, Ms Lautrette, and the University and Career Counsellor, Ms Doell, will take place before the spring break. Successful candidates will then be interviewed by the Internship Company for final selection.
